

## **Services in the Sanctuary are starting again!!**

Starting Sunday July 5 we plan to run two services, one at 9:00AM and again at 10:45AM, with the same style and format for each. We will practice physical distancing from those who are not living in your household, but that will not keep us from filling the sanctuary with music, hearing the buzz of people from young to old, and enjoying some great teaching and inspiration from the book of Psalms.

We will clean all door handles and bathrooms in between services. If you have any COVID symptoms or have travelled to places where there are cases, please choose to stay at home for the well being of all the other attendees.

We are allowed 3 groups of 50 people in the sanctuary. Each group of 50 will remain separate, from the door they enter, to the use of bathrooms, and to the children's play area.

Giving on-line will continue to be encouraged and lock boxes will be available at each sanctuary door to place donations. The library and the mailboxes will not be open to the public on Sunday mornings.

- **Group A** will enter the church at the southeast corner, near the road, use the basement washrooms, be seated on the South section, and the children's play area will be in the basement preschool area.
- **Group B** will enter the east (most used) entrance, be seated in the center of the sanctuary, use the main washrooms and have a children's play area in the foyer.
- **Group C** will enter the church on ground level near the elevator, use the handicap washroom, be seated on the west side of the sanctuary and have the children's play area in the upstairs nursery.
- **The overflow** (after 50 in each section) will be upstairs in the youth room, watching livestream, with use of the upstairs washrooms.

**Because we are limited to 3 groups of 50 in the sanctuary we will need to try to make sure we do not have an overabundance of people at one service and very few at the other. So could you please indicate if you prefer to be primarily at the 9:00 or the 10:45 service, and let Lisa know as soon as possible what your preference will be.**
