"Daily Bread & Living Bread"

Scripture: John 6:32-33 - "Moses didn't give you bread from heaven. My Father did. And now he offers you the true bread from heaven. The true bread of God is the one who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

1.	Have you ever been in a place of desperate need for food, shelter or safety? Do you know others who have?
2.	In John 6:26-35 Jesus is referring to himself as true and living bread that satisfies more permanently than bread made of dough. Does the request for daily bread represent food for the stomach or spiritual truth for the soul?
3.	The Lord's Prayer is in Matthew 6:10-14 and later in the chapter 6:25-34, Jesus challenges his people to not worry, about food and clothes because God values us more than lilies and sparrows. How do you differentiate between being responsible and worry?
4.	When we pray "give us", how much responsibility should we or can we take for the food needs of the whole world?
5.	Would you agree that wealthy well fed Christians struggle with an inflated view their own self sufficiency? How can we stay aware of our neediness and God's generous provision?
6.	Are we aware of the line between needs and wants in our lives?
7.	A loving Father enjoys providing for his family. Is it only needs he enjoys providing or

does he also enjoy providing wants?
