We attend the Blumenort Community Church regularly and consider it our home church. We are in agreement with core church practices and the Evangelical Mennonite Conference statement of faith, to the extent that we can serve as part of our local church family.

While on stage, we avoid clothing that is too revealing, has large logos, or could be seen as controversial or distracting.
